Crystal Soap

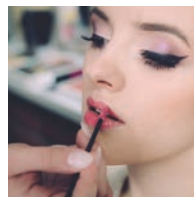

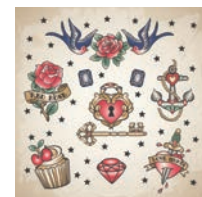
Celebrate spring by making your own seasonal wreath.
