ARTWORK GUIDELINES & SALES

Educators may enter a maximum of THREE ORIGINAL ARTWORKS—no copies or reproductions—in any medium. Spiva reserves the right to omit up to 2 works with regards to space limitations and/or layout needs.

Artwork previously shown at Spiva is not eligible for this exhibit no matter in which gallery it was shown.

All two-dimensional work must be suitably presented and ready to hang with wires firmly attached. All three-dimensional work must be properly based. No work can be suspended from the ceiling. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS, SLOT HANGERS, OR GLASS AND CLIPS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Work that exceeds 72”x72”, including the frame, or any work exceeding 100 pounds, will not be accepted.

Sales of art will be encouraged. Spiva Center for the Arts will retain a 30% commission on all sales that occur as a result of this exhibit.
