What is Lunch Club?

Lunch Club is a convenient midday care solution for full day campers. The program runs for the entire week of camp sessions at \$5 per day. To sign up for Lunch Club, just add it to your cart during camp registration!

Can children join the lunch club if they're not enrolled in a full camp day?

Yes! If you would like to drop off your child 30 minutes before afternoon camps or have your student picked up 30 minutes after morning camp ends, they are welcome to participate in the lunch club and eat their lunch on site.

Is lunch provided?

No. Students must bring their own bag or sack lunch that can be stored in their non-refrigerated cubby by the classrooms.

Tues-Thurs, July 7-9, 1 - 5 pm



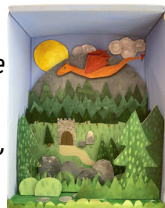

Tues-Thurs, July 21-23, 9 am - 12:30 pm

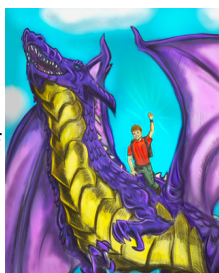
We are donning our lab coats and goggles for this summer camp! Get ready for an exciting lineup that includes slime making, ice painting, flower dyeing, and much more.
